Amending Court's Order of July 25, 1984 (Civ. O.B. 90, p. 29)

The President of the United States, having signed into law the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984, on July 10, 1984, and the President having signed the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994 on October 22, 1994;

AND WHEREAS Section 157(a), Chapter 6 of Title 28, United States Code, states that "Each district court may provide that any and all cases under title 11 and any or all proceedings arising under title 11 or arising in or related to a case under title 11 shall be referred to the bankruptcy judges for the district;"

AND WHEREAS Section 157(e) of Title 28 was amended by the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994 to provide that bankruptcy judges may conduct jury trials if specifically designated to do so by the district court and with the expressed consent of all parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 157(a), it is ORDERED that all cases under Title 11 and all proceedings arising under Title 11 U.S.C., or arising in or relating to a case under Title 11 U.S.C., pending on this date or filed on or after this date, in the Western District of Virginia, are referred to the bankruptcy judges for this district, to be assigned in accordance with their assignment rules.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that the bankruptcy judges of this district are hereby specifically designated to conduct jury trials when all parties have expressly consented thereto.

The clerk is directed to send certified copies of this order to the judges, clerks and divisional offices of the United States District Court and the United States Bankruptcy Court of the Western District of Virginia.
